Long awaited summer has arrived and many new things will be happening here in Weybridge. First, we welcome the many new residents who have moved into Weybridge over the past few months.

The City of Dublin has approved the curb and street repairs which will take place mid-summer. The curb-end of all driveways will be affected so, the driveway sealing for this year will be postponed until the street repairs are completed.

Your landscape and exterior home improvements need prior approval from Weybridge HOA before being forwarded to Muirfield Association for final approval. The forms and guidelines can be found on the Weybridge HOA website under the *Resource Center* tab of the main menu, or obtained from any of your Weybridge board members.

Your Weybridge Board met with Jeffery Kaman, of Kaman & Cusimano Attorneys at Law. The firm specializes in Ohio Homeowners Association law. They are advising us about changes that may needed in our Code of Regulations, updating of our Statutory Agent of Record, and obtaining Directors and Officers Insurance

coverage. All the change recommendations will be carefully considered before enacting.

I would like to remind all residents of some of their responsibilities stated in the warranty deed:

Please read those concerning the garage door, and parking-in-driveway requirements. Also, inspect your homes for the condition of paint and trim, and the condition of your roof and gutters. When all residents abide by these standards the value of our properties will continue to increase.

One evening in the next few weeks you may find a group of your neighbors wandering through your yard. It will be your Board members conducting their spring walk-around. Twice a year the members walk through the neighborhood to observe property maintenance levels, dead shrubs & trees, and Code of Regulation compliance issues. These are noted and where action is required, residents will be contacted.

This is an obligation of the residents elected to the Board and is done in a friendly, cooperative spirit. If you see us please come out and talk, we would love to meet you.

Remember, it is the residents that make Weybridge great! Take advantage of all the amenities that are here in Muirfield and enjoy your summer!
